# HOW TO WALK WITH GOD

Heb 11:5, 6

#### INTRO

- Today we are blessed to participate in the **baptism** of **4** dear saints
  - For their benefit ... and ours ... we'll explore: How to Walk with God
- Thus far in our series from Hebrews Chpt 11 ~~ we've learned from **Abel** that in order to be **get right** with God ... we must come to God by way of a <u>blood</u> sacrifice
  - Today Enoch will show us how to stay right w/ God ~ walking w/ God
    - **Enoch** *the father of Methuselah* lived prior to the Flood
      - Which was a very difficult time for God's Children ... Gen 6:5, 6
- Earth was <u>no longer</u> the paradise God created ~ it was <u>no longer</u> a place of fellowship between **God** the **C**reator *and* **H**is creation
  - However ~ Enoch hadn't give into the pressures of his sin-sick culture -- he didn't live a "politically correct" life
    - <u>Baptism Candidates</u> Following the Crowd can lead you to <u>no</u> where
- Instead of doing the popular thing ~ **Enoch** decided to do the **right thing** 
  - So ... by faith ~ Enoch walked with God
    - To learn from his example ~ we need to consider four aspects of the life of Enoch ... beginning with:

### ENOCH'S PERSUASION ABOUT GOD [Faith]

Bottom line: God doesn't want us to have a religion ... He wants us to have a relationship

- Enoch is listed in "Faith's Hall of Fame" ... for a very specific reason: Heb 11:5
  - Faith in the Bible means a firm persuasion which guides/directs one's actions
    - Columbus believed the world was round ... 7 yrs for \$\$ ... he sailed west
      - A great Biblical illustration of Faith is found in Rom 4:19 21

- When we reflect upon Enoch's faith ... Hebrews 11:6 makes more sense
- Important for us to understand the kind of faith which pleases God (Last Sabbath)
  - $\circ$  Of course we must believe that God exists  $\sim$  but **not** like a **Deist** 
    - A faith which enables us to walk with God in a way which pleases Him involves more than just believing in an <u>impersonal</u> Creator
- Let's notice how King David illustrates this truth ... Psm 139:13 & 16
  - When we were being formed in our mother's womb ... God was already our personal Lord ~~ and He had a plan for our lives
    - Enoch was firmly persuaded that God wasn't only the Great Creator ...
      - but also a God w/ whom he had a personal relationship

**TRANS:** We too can have faith in a **Creator** ~ **personal** God ... let's also notice:

## ENOCH'S MEDITATION ON GOD

- We need to internalize the truth of Heb 11:6 b
  - $\circ$  God rewards those who seek fellowship with Him  $\sim$  He respects our choice
    - Diligently/earnestly is interesting = sincerely, seriously, productively
      - So how did Enoch 'earnestly' seek fellowship with God ...
        - ... there was **no** face-to-face interaction anymore ...
        - ... there was **no** weekly Sabbath worship to attend ...
        - ... there was **no** written word for him to read
          - Enoch <u>meditated</u> on God
- Term many aren't familiar with  $\sim$  some associate it w/ Eastern mythical religions
  - Truth is ~~ we all meditate ... we just call it something else: worry

- If we know how to **worry** ... then we know how to **meditate** 
  - <u>Worry</u> is taking a negative thought and thinking **@** it over, and over, and over
    - <u>Meditation</u> is taking Scripture and thinking about it over and over ...
      - ... with the **purpose** of applying the principles to one's life
        - Joshua 1:8 [Book of the Law written by Moses; <u>authoritative</u>]
- Meditation is essential for our walking with God
  - Walking with God requires both knowing ... and ... obeying God's Word
    - In our sermon on Cain & Able  $\ \ --\ \$ we saw one meditated  $\ \sim\$ other didn't
  - Enoch's life is summed up in just four verses of Genesis Chpt 5 ...
    - ... and twice in those verses we're told: Enoch walked with God
- Please be aware there's something very real which can prevent us from walking w/God:
  - o Ish 59:2
    - Iniquity = an act of injustice
    - Sin = conduct contrary to Gods Word
      - So ~ when we abandon fairness when dealing with people ... or have unconfessed sin in our life - God will not walk w/ us
        - God gives us a list of the most common sins which prevent us from walking with Him: Eph 4:31 //
- Some of you are thinking ... why are so many sins **omitted** from this list  $\sim \sim$  like:
  - $\circ$  Stealing ~ drunkenness ~ lying ~ murder ~ sexual immorality
    - To walk with God ... we must not only avoid sinful behaviors ... we must also replace them ~ look at V 32
      - When we're obedient to V 32 ~ we won't do those "other sins"
- **TRANS:** To walk with God ... we need faith in a **Creator personal** God ... we must **meditate** on Him and His Word ~~ there's more:

## ENOCH'S PROCLAMATION ABOUT GOD

• To walk with God - Enoch went against the expectations of the wicked culture  $\sim$  and he proclaimed God's Truth to a sinn-sick world

#### Jude 14, 15

- $\circ$  We serve a God of love, mercy, and grace  $\sim \sim$  but He's also punishes sin
  - God loves the sinner ... but ... not their sin
    - It is often overlooked today ... but **Jesus** taught more about **Judgment** than He did about reward and Heaven
- Gen 5:22 tells us Enoch walked with God for 300 years ...
  - *Today* ~ if we want to walk with God ... we must consistently meditate on His Word by reading it / living it / and **sharing** it
    - As we start 2020 ... how many of us can say the Holy Spirit used us to lead a sinner to their Savior in 2019 { P }
- **TRANS:** Not only do we need faith in our **Creator personal** God ... but this faith needs to lead us to **contemplate** Him, His Word ~ and then be His **witness** to others

Finally ... let's consider:

## **ENOCH'S TRANSLATION BY GOD**

• God was so please w/ how **Enoch walked with Him** ... apparently ... He wanted Enoch to come to Heaven

#### o Gen 5:24

- Some assert this was the most significant event of the **antediluvian** era
  - Enoch's departure was seen by the righteous and wicked (PP/88)
- o God used this event to motivate the few living faithful ... and ...
  - ... to validate the certainty of His promised deliverance from sin / death
- Bible **doesn't** say **HOW** God accomplished this impressive feat ...
  - ... only 1 other saint was translated into Heaven w/o dying 2 Kings 2:11

- God may have taken Enoch like He translated Elijah ~ or:
  - $\circ$  ... it may have been like the translation of believers when Jesus returns:

1 Thess 4:16, 17

- **"HOW"** God took **Enoch** is an interesting question to ponder ~ but it's not critical ... or God would have told us how He did it
  - The important thing is <u>not</u> **HOW** ... but rather **TO WHERE**
- This is true for you and me ...
  - $\circ$  It's not really important <u>when</u> we die  $\sim$  <u>where</u> or- <u>how</u> we die
  - The only important thing is where we'll spend eternity
    - If we're like Enoch ...
      - And **believe** that God is ... and He rewards those who **seek** after Him through Jesus ...
        - o ... and **walk** with God while we await Christ's return ...
  - **THEN** ~ one day ... *maybe sooner than we think* ... we'll go to be with God and find that God is also pleased with us
    - By walking with God ~ we can anticipate hearing:

Well done, good and faithful servant
