- Expression used exclusively by Matthew
 - (31 times) in the NT
- Similar to "Kingdom of God"
 - Purpose of Messiah
- **Luke 4:43**
- But he said to them, "I must preach the good news of the kingdom of God to the other towns as well; for I was sent for this purpose."
- Established at first advent
- Jesus is King,
- Subjects those who believed
- Territory hearts and lives

VIRGINS

- represent purity
- > all of those who profess the pure faith of Jesus.
- > They believe in the soon coming of Jesus.
- Revelation 14:4
- It is these who have not defiled themselves with women, for they are virgins. It is these who follow the Lamb wherever he goes. These have been redeemed from mankind as firstfruits for God and the Lamb,

LAMPS

- It was their version of a flashlight
- > Bowl of <u>oil</u> with wick
- It gives <u>light</u>
 - Light is a symbol of truth
- Psalm 119:105
- > Your word is a lamp to my feet and a light to my path.

Five of them were foolish, and five were wise. For when the foolish took their lamps, they took no oil with them, but the wise took flasks of oil with their lamps.

FOOLISH

- What made them foolish?
 - Had lamps
 - But not enough oil
 - What do lamps symbolize?
- OIL
 - ➤ = Holy Spirit
- Luke 4:18

"The Spirit of the LORD is upon Me, Because He has anointed Me To preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted, To proclaim liberty to the captives And recovery of sight to the blind, To set at liberty those who are oppressed;

As the bridegroom was delayed, they all became drowsy and slept.

DELAYED

- > Why delay?

- They will say, "Where is the promise of his coming? For ever since the fathers fell asleep, all things are continuing as they were from the beginning of creation."

- The Lord is not slow to fulfill his promise as some count slowness, but is patient toward you, not wishing that any should perish, but that all should reach repentance.

- > How many?
 - Wise and Foolish
- Jesus repeatedly says:
- Matthew 24:42–44
- Therefore, stay awake, for you do not know on what day your Lord is coming. But know this, that if the master of the house had known in what part of the night the thief was coming, he would have stayed awake and would not have let his house be broken into. Therefore you also must be ready, for the Son of Man is coming at an hour you do not expect.
- 1 Thessalonians 5:2–4
- For you yourselves are fully aware that the day of the Lord will come like a thief in the night. While people are saying, "There is peace and security," then sudden destruction will come upon them as labor pains come upon a pregnant woman, and they will not escape. But you are not in darkness, brothers, for that day to surprise you like a thief.
- Sleeping
 - Opposite of being ready

Christ Object Lessons p. 408

- In the parable, all the ten virgins went out to meet the bridegroom. All had lamps and vessels for oil. For a time there was seen no difference between them. So with the church that lives just before Christ's second coming. All have a knowledge of the Scriptures. All have heard the message of Christ's near approach, and confidently expect His appearing. But as in the parable, so it is now. A time of waiting intervenes, faith is tried; and when the cry is heard, "Behold, the bridegroom cometh," ... many are unready. They have no oil in their vessels with their lamps. They are destitute of the Holy Spirit....
 - How is your
 - spiritual life
 - during this time
 - > of waiting?
- The theory of truth, unaccompanied by the Holy Spirit, cannot quicken the soul or sanctify the heart. One may be familiar with the commands and promises of the Bible; but unless the Spirit of God sets the truth home, the character will not be transformed. Without the enlightenment of the Spirit, men will not be able to distinguish truth from error, and they will fall under the masterful temptations of Satan.
 - You are not saved by
 - being SDA
 - being at church
 - memorizing text
 - exposure to truth

- But
 - seeking God
 - with all heart.
 - allowing truth
 - change your heart

But at midnight there was a cry, 'Here is the bridegroom! Come out to meet him.'

- MIDNIGHT
 - Symbolically,
 - The darkest hour

Christ Object Lessons p. 414

- The coming of the bridegroom was at midnight—the darkest hour. So the coming of Christ will take place in the darkest period of this earth's history.

 - When all sleep
 - Are unprepared
 - Are unholy
 "Nothing Good Happens after 11pm"
- ➢ Isaiah 60:1−2
- Arise, shine, for your light has come, and the glory of the LORD has risen upon you. For behold, darkness shall cover the earth, and thick darkness the peoples; but the LORD will arise upon you, and his glory will be seen upon you.

CRY / SHOUT

- > What is this?
- > 1 Thessalonians 4:16
- For the Lord himself will descend from heaven with a <u>cry</u> [shout] of command, with the voice of an archangel, and with the sound of the trumpet of God. And the dead in Christ will rise first.
- Announcement of arrival
 - Too late to prepare

SHUT DOOR

- Close probation
 - No forgiveness
 - Too late
- > Foolish repent?
- Hebrews 12:16–17
- … like Esau, who sold his birthright for a single meal. For you know that afterward, when he desired to inherit the blessing, he was rejected, for he found no chance to repent, though he sought it with tears.
- Repented of consequences
 - Not sin
- > They don't enjoy heaven.
 - They enjoy world
- Shut out
 - by their own unfitness.

MATTHEW 25:11-12

Afterward the other virgins came also, saying, 'Lord, lord, open to us.' But he answered, 'Truly, I say to you, I do not know you.'

Therefore stay awake—for you do not know when the master of the house will come, in the evening, or at midnight, or when the rooster crows, or in the morning— lest he come suddenly and find you asleep. And what I say to you I say to all: Stay awake."

Bissel's Ride

Thanks to the poet Henry Wadsworth Longfellow, everyone has heard of the "midnight ride of Paul Revere." But few have heard of Israel Bissel, a humble post rider on the Boston-New York route.

After the Battle of Lexington and Concord on April 19, 1775, Bissel was ordered to raise the alarm in New Haven, Connecticut. He reached Worchester, Mass., normally a day's ride, in two hours. There, according to tradition, his horse promptly dropped dead. Pausing only to get another mount, Bissel pressed on and by April 22 was in New Haven--but he didn't stop there! He rode on to New York, arriving April 24, and then stayed in the saddle until he reached Philadelphia the next day. Bissel's 126 hour, 345 mile ride signaled American militia units throughout the Northeast to mobilize for war.
