A Day in the Life of Christ

- Recently gathered 12
- Goes to Capernaum

Mark 1:21-22 ESV

And they went into Capernaum, and immediately on the Sabbath he entered the synagogue and was teaching. And they were astonished at his teaching, for he taught them as one who had authority, and not as the scribes.

- Jesus did more
 - teaching than preaching
 - More healing that teaching

Mark 1:23-24 ESV

And immediately there was in their synagogue a man with an unclean spirit. And he cried out, "What have you to do with us, Jesus of Nazareth? Have you come to destroy us? I know who you are—the Holy One of God."

- Satan testifying
 - creating confusion?
- Trying to
 - destroy teaching
 - create distraction.

Mark 1:25-28 ESV

But Jesus rebuked him, saying, "Be silent, and come out of him!" And the unclean spirit, convulsing him and crying out with a loud voice, came out of him. And they were all amazed, so that they questioned among themselves, saying, "What is this? A new teaching with authority! He commands even the unclean spirits, and they obey him." And at once his fame spread everywhere throughout all the surrounding region of Galilee.

- People are amazed
- Jesus goes to church
 - teaches
 - heals.

Mark 1:29-31 ESV

And immediately he left the synagogue and entered the house of Simon and Andrew, with James and John. Now Simon's mother-in-law lay ill with a fever, and immediately they told him about her. And he came and took her by the hand and lifted her up, and the fever left her, and she began to serve them.

- Potluck Peter's house
 - problem...

- mom is sick...
- No problem,
 - Jesus heals her to.
 - Potluck is on!

- What did he do?
 - next verse...

Mark 1:35 ESV

And rising very early in the morning, while it was still dark, he departed and went out to a desolate place, and there he prayed.

- First priority?
 - connection to Father
- Daily toil
 - connection
 - abiding
 - or fruitless.

What happens next?

Mark 1:36-37 ESV

And Simon and those who were with him searched for him, and they found him and said to him, "Everyone is looking for you."

- Looking for Him
 - try to find Him.
 - another line...

- Christ was tireless
 - in service.
- Especially on Sabbath!!
- Christians Should Too.

Sabbath is Boring
