What does it really mean to be a member of the body? How do I know if I'm experiencing the fullness of what Christ desires in my relationship with the Church?

The Body

1 Corinthians 12:12–13 **ESV**

For just as the body is one and has many members, and all the members of the body, though many, are one body, so it is with Christ. For in one Spirit we were all baptized into one body—Jews or Greeks, slaves or free—and all were made to drink of one Spirit.

- What metaphor?
 - Body

- Why
 - many parts
 - work together unitedly
 - no jealousy

- In human body
 - one part not working
 - illness
 - sick
 - body part attack body
 - auto immune disease
- Healthy Body
 - Healthy church
 - all active
 - all connected
 - all united
 - all working
- Christ describes
 - relationship to church
 - relationship to spouse

- Marriage as metaphor
 - Christian's relationship
 - with Jesus Christ.

Ephesians 5:22–28 **ESV**

Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord. For the husband is the head of the wife even as Christ is the head of the church, his body, and is himself its Savior. Now as the church submits to Christ, so also wives should submit in everything to their husbands.

Husbands, love your wives, as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her, that he might sanctify her, having cleansed her by the washing of water with the word, so that he might present the church to himself in splendor, without spot or wrinkle or any such thing, that she might be holy and without blemish. In the same way husbands should love their wives as their own bodies. He who loves his wife loves himself.

together.

- Love Christ
 - Love Church

Hebrews 10:24–25 ESV

And let us consider how to stir up one another to love and good works, not neglecting to meet together, as is the habit of some, but encouraging one

another, and all the more as you see the Day drawing near.

Luke 4:16 ESV

And he came to Nazareth, where he had been brought up. And as was his custom, he went to the synagogue on the Sabbath day, and he stood up to read.

- People say:

What does Bible teach?

Leviticus 23:3 ESV

"Six days shall work be done, but on the seventh day is a Sabbath of solemn rest, a holy convocation. You shall do no work. It is a Sabbath to the LORD in all your dwelling places.

- Sabbath is
 - holy convocation
 - sacred assembly
 - (meeting together!)
- If we want to see
 - ideal Sabbath

- Example of heaven:

[Isaiah 66:23](#) (ESV)

From new moon to new moon, and from Sabbath to Sabbath, all flesh shall come to worship before me, declares the LORD.

- What is it like?
 - come together
 - worship God
