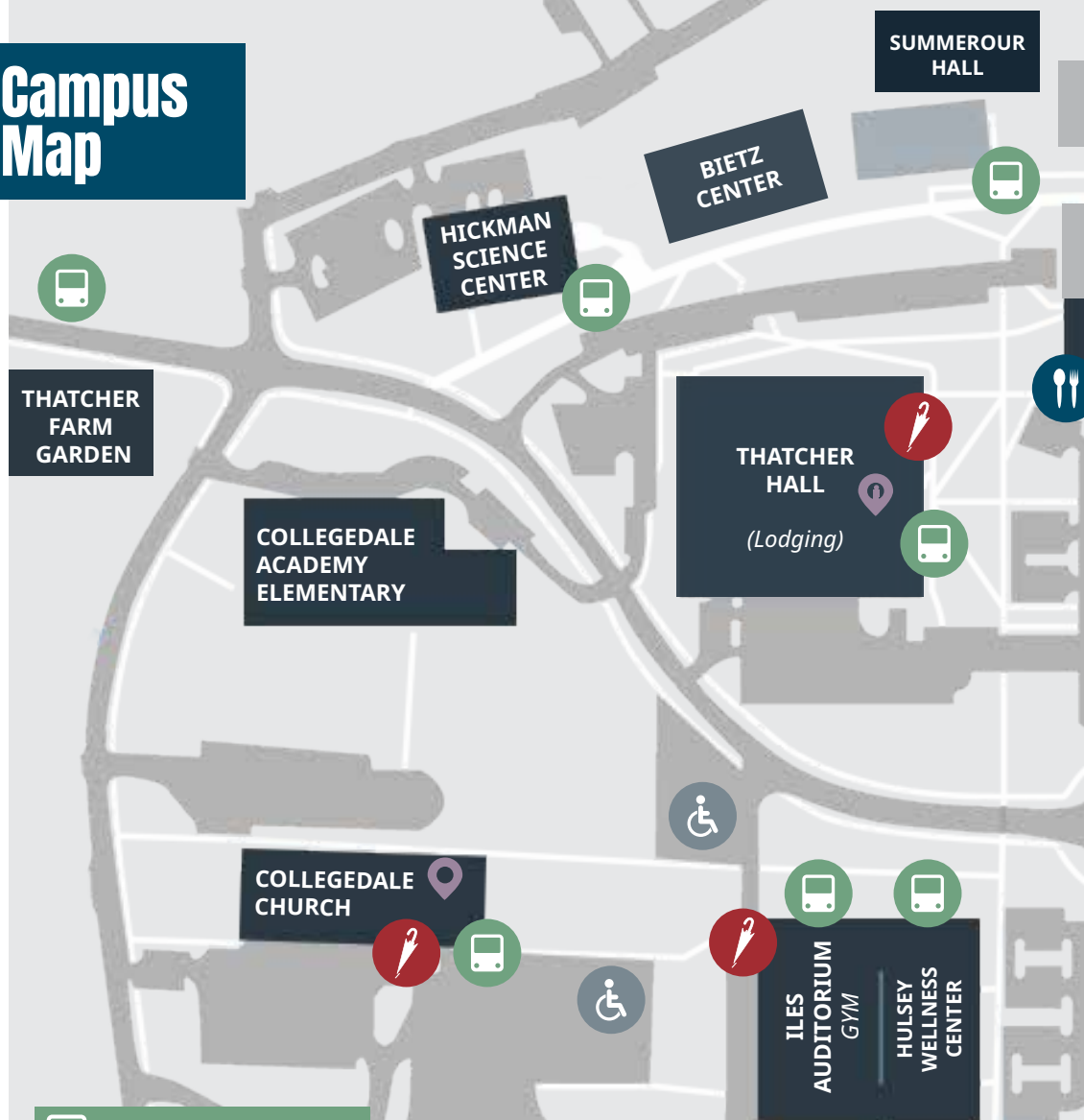

Handicap parking can be found in the Collegedale Church parking lot, lower lot near Iles Auditorium, and side parking lot for Iles Auditorium.

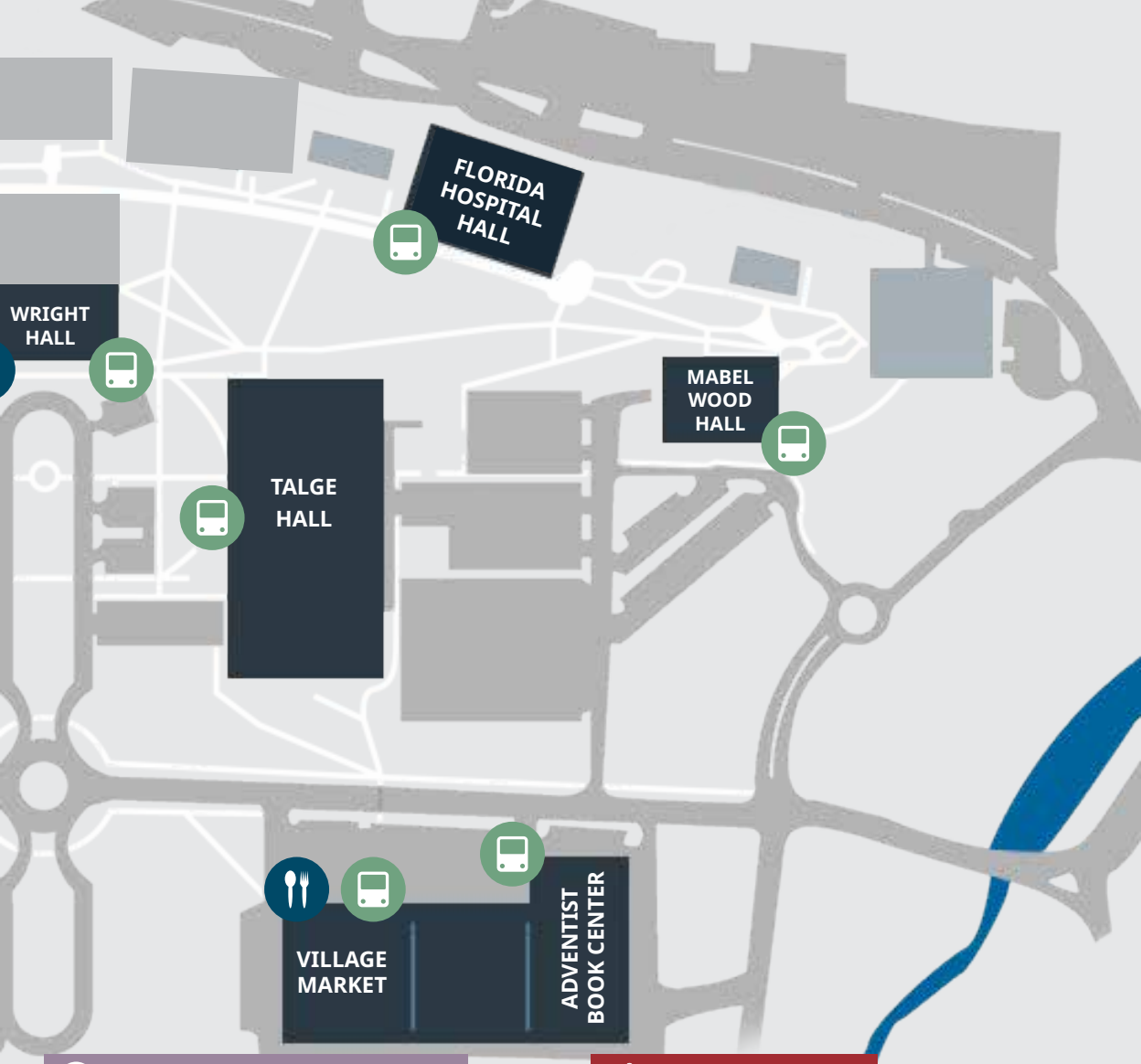

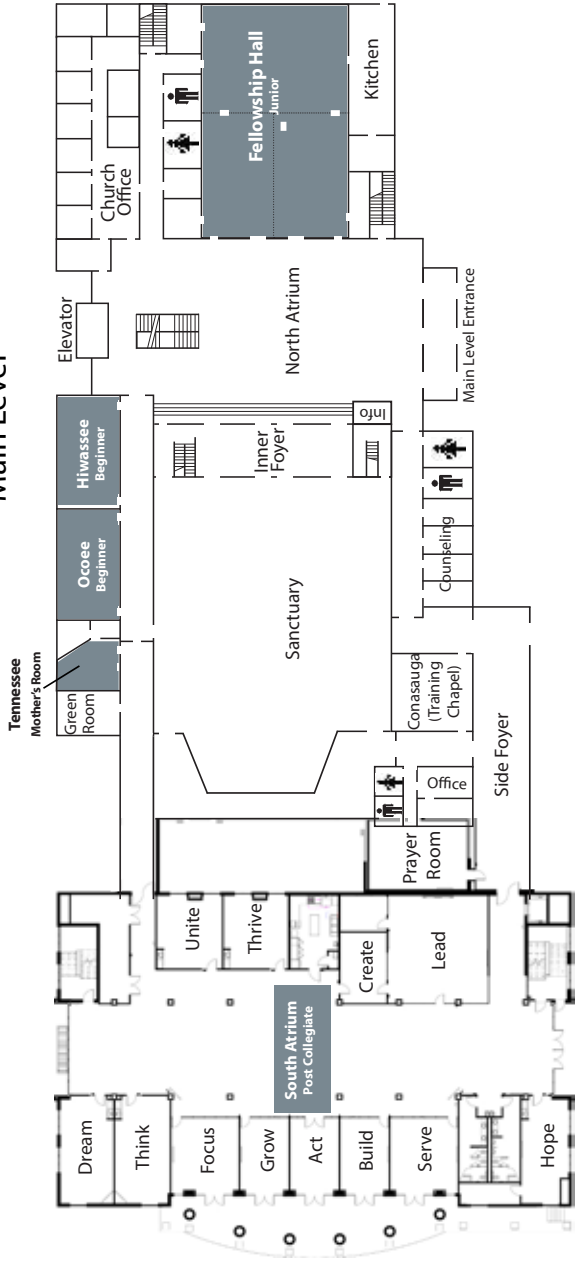

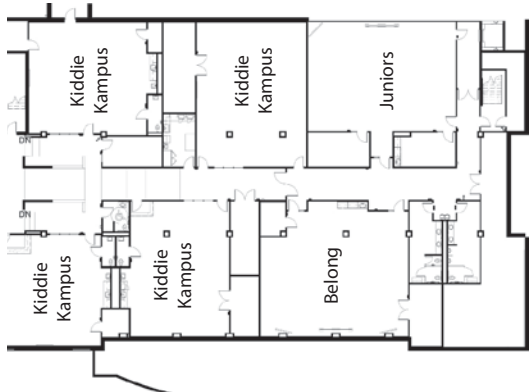

MAP OF COLLEDALE CHURCH

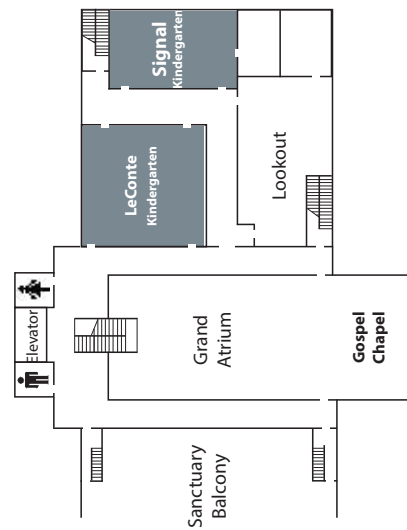

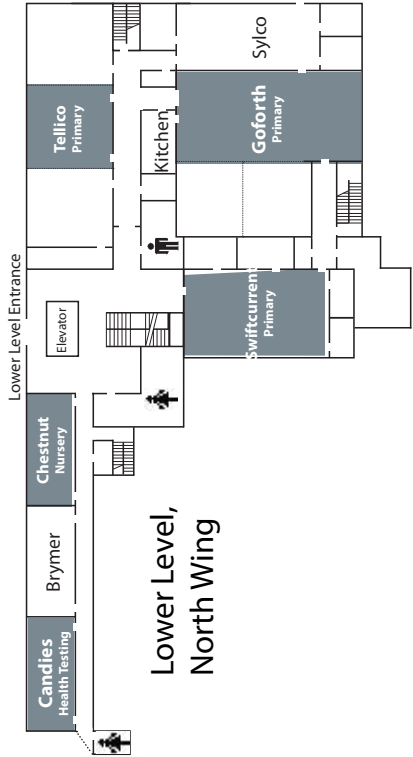
South Wing, Lower Level
